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RESOLUTION NO. 3

"WHEREAS, LGU Bayawan requires a multi-chambered (3-chamber) septic tank for solids/liquid waste coming from toilets consistent with the provisions of RA 9275 otherwise known as the Clean Water Act of 2004 and the Healthy City Program;

"WHEREAS, although effluent coming from septic tank is raw sewage, septic tank is a first step in septic management which is simple, affordable and doable;

"NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Guillermo A. Diao and duly seconded by Honorable Councilor Barte, the Council

"RESOLVED, to enact an ordinance to read as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS, MARKETS, AND SLAUGHTERHOUSE TO ADOPT 3-CHAMBERED SEPTIC TANK FOR WASTE MATTERS AND PROVIDING PENALTY THEREFOR.

Be it ordained that:

Section 1. Short title. 3-CHAMBERED SEPTIC TANK

Section 2. Definition:

A. Septic tank - a water tight tank or container, normally with one inlet and one outlet, which retains wastewater and reduces its strength by settlement and anaerobic digestion of excreta.

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B. Wastewater (sewage) – water carrying waste from homes, businesses and industries that is a mixture of water and dissolved or suspended solids.

Section 3. Building permit – 3-chambered septic tank is one of the basic requirements in the issuance/grating of building permit.

Section 4. Coverage – All on going building constructions for residential, commercial, industrial market and slaughterhouse shall adopt the 3-chambered septic tank and as essential part of the said construction. After three (3) years of the passage of this Ordinance, owners of old buildings shall redesign/upgrade their existing vaults of the septic tanks to conform with this Ordinance.

Section 5. Enforcement Committee – The City Mayor shall create a committee of 4 members and is tasked to implement this ordinance with the following composition:

1. City Pollution Officer – Chairman
2. Building Officer – member
3. Sanitary Inspector – member
4. Engineer from CPDO – member

Violation of said ordinance shall be immediately reported to the Local Chief Executive for appropriate action.

Section 6. Penalty.


- a) First Offense - Fine of PHP500.00
- b) Second Offense - Fine of PHP1,000.00
- c) Third Offense - Fine of PHP2,500.00 or an imprisonment of 3 months or both at the discretion of the court.

Section 7. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect after compliance with the provisions of RA 7160, Local Government Code of 1991.
